#### **Project Description, Objectives**

07.11.2023

I. Expanding the vocational education system for housing management and maintenance – develop and approve professional standards for housing managers and caretakers; based on them developing educational programs, launching them in colleges; starting training of vocational students.

II. Enhancing the involvement of business intermediary organizations (BIOs) in housing policy decision-making processes in the partner countries and increasing their capacity.

#### **Target groups**

- micro, small and medium-sized enterprises (MSMEs) of housing management and maintenance, BIOs
- educational institutions and colleges
- national and local authorities.

#### **PROJECT RESULTS**

#### PROFESSIONAL EDUCATION

- new specialties "Housing manager" and "Caretaker" have been introduced into vocational training in partner countries
- professional standards and educational programmes for colleges have been developed and approved
- the first intake of students was carried out:
  - 2022–23: 125 students (Kazakhstan)
  - 2023: 18 students accepted for studying in 2024 (Uzbekistan)

## TRAINING DURING THE PROJECT AND EXCHANGE OF EXPERIENCE

- 2020–2023: educational programme "Training of Trainers" (ToT) for the target groups 256 academic hours, 1300 participants, experts from 9 countries in Europe and Central Asia, materials on the project website: https://uyushma.uz/biblioteka
- BIOs have developed concepts for providing advanced training services for housing managers. A series of seminars was held:
  - 20 days / 168 participants (Kazakhstan)
  - 20 days / 362 participants (Uzbekistan)
- project partners organised and conducted 5 study tours & 3 regional conferences

#### **INVOLVEMENT OF BIOS**

- 2020–2023 partners held / participated actively in round tables, information events, consultations:
  - 83 events / 4601 participants (Kazakhstan)
  - 32 events / 757 participants (Uzbekistan)
